Summary of Report and Recommendations

The 'Brasilia Declaration' affirmed road safety as a global development priority; welcomed the road safety targets set by Sustainable Development Goals 3 & 11; highlighted related global agreements, priorities, initiatives and new partners; and recommended actions to:

- strengthen road safety management and improve legislation and enforcement;
- promote safer roads and the use of sustainable modes of transportation;
- protect vulnerable road users;
- develop and promote the use of safer vehicles;
- increase awareness and build capacity of road users;
- improve post-crash response and rehabilitation services; and
- strengthen cooperation and coordination towards global road safety.

The objective of the report is to identify and assess innovative financing opportunities arising from the global trade in imported second-hand motor vehicles. These opportunities and mechanisms will be designed to boost delivery of the Brasilia Declaration recommendations.

The method of assessment comprised three key steps. First, a strategic scan was conducted to form a broad picture of the scale of the imported second-hand vehicle market, the nature of the innovative financing mechanism that could be best aligned with this market, and the potential funding streams that could be generated. Second, a brief literature review of innovative financing mechanisms and their effectiveness was conducted to identify potential applications in the imported second-hand vehicle market. Third, an assessment of the proposed mechanism was made, using a comprehensive screening framework previously prepared to evaluate a long list of innovative financing mechanisms designed to support health systems in developing countries.
